- WHEREAS the recruitment of the staff unit referred to in this notice will be made from the resources of the project and therefore the taking up of employment is subject to the granting of funding;

DECREES

Art. 1

Competition places

A public competition is called, based on qualifications and exams, for the recruitment of no. 1 Technologist, Level II - fixed-term economic position D5 for a duration of 18 months, possibly renewable, full-time commitment basis at the Department of Economics, Management and Business Law of the University of Bari Aldo Moro, as part of the National Recovery and Resilience Plan, Mission 4 "Education and research" Component 2 Investment 1.3 "Partnerships extended to universities, research centers and companies for the financing of basic research projects" financed by the European Union - NextGenerationEU, for the "GRINS – Growing Resilient, Inclusive and Sustainable" Project (project code PE0000018_CUP H93C22000650001), whose contact person is Prof. Angela Stefania Bergantino.

The Technologist, within the framework of the directives given to him/her by the Project Manager, will have to deal with:

- carrying out technical, administrative and scientific support activities for the research activities of the GRINS project, with particular reference to the management of databases, software and research laboratories;
- management of cloud platforms to support scientific applications and support of users of the GRINS communities for access to the data/models produced by Spoke 7.

The contract will be activated with resources from the endowment of the National Recovery and Resilience Plan (PNRR) therefore, **the taking up of service will be subject to the granting of loans**. In any case, the contract must be concluded by the project end date, by November 30, 2025, unless the same project is extended.

The University guarantees equal opportunities between men and women for access to employment and treatment at work.

Art. 2

Competition admission requirements

The admission to the competition requires the following requirements:

1) Italian citizenship or citizenship of a member state of the European Union. Family members of citizens of Member States of the European Union who are not nationals of a Member State and

who hold the right of residence or the right of permanent residence; holders of the EU residence permit for long-term residents, holders of refugee status or subsidiary protection status will also be admitted to the selection;

- 2) age not less than 18 years;
- 3) be in possession of one of the following qualifications: LM-17 Physics, LM-18 Computer Science, LM-23 Civil Engineering, LM-31 Industrial Engineering, LM-32 Engineering in Computer Science, LM-35 Environmental Engineering, LM-44 Data Science and Scientific Computing, LM-49 Planning and governance of tourism systems, LM-56 Economic Sciences, LM-76 Environmental and food economics, LM-77 Business Economic Sciences, LM-82 Statistical Sciences, LM-83 Sciences actuarial and financial statistics, LM-Data, LM-88 Sociology and Social Research, LM-91 Data Science for Management or equivalent degree pursuant to the D.1. 09/07/2009;
- 4) documented professional experience of at least one year relating to the activities referred to in the previous art. 1, worked for public administrations, private companies or as a freelancer;
- 5) physical suitability for employment. The Administration has the right to submit the winners of the competition to a medical check, based on current legislation;
- 6) regular position with regard to military obligations (for male applicants born before 01/01/1986);
- 7) enjoyment of civil and political rights. For applicants who are not Italian citizens and do not hold refugee or subsidiary protection status, the enjoyment of civil and political rights refers to the country of citizenship.

Those who have been excluded from the active political electorate and those who have been dismissed or exempt from employment with a public administration for persistent insufficient performance, or have been declared ineligible from a state employment, pursuant to art. 127, paragraph l, letter d) of the T.U. of civil employees of the State, approved by D.P.R. 10/01/1957 n. 3.

Citizens of Member States of the European Union, family Union citizens who are not citizens of a Member State who hold the right of residence or the right of permanent residence, holders of EU long-term residence permit, holders of refugee status or subsidiary protection status must meet the following requirements:

- a) be in possession, with the exception of the ownership of Italian citizenship, of all the other requirements provided for citizens of the Republic;
- b) have adequate knowledge of the Italian language.

The aforementioned requirements must be hold both on the date of the deadline for submitting applications for the competition and at the time of signing the contract. Applicants are admitted to the competition with reservation. The Administration may order, at any stage of the procedure, by reasoned order of the General Director, exclusion for lack of the prescribed requirements.

It should be noticed that pursuant to Article 55-quater of Legislative Decree No. 165/2001, as amended and integrated, false documents or declarations committed for the purposes of or at the time of the establishment of the employment relationship or career progressions lead to dismissal without notice.

Article 3

Application and submission deadline

The application form, as well as the useful documents for the competition must be submitted, **under penalty of exclusion**, electronically, using the dedicated computer application on the page https://pica.cineca.it/uniba/24pnrr244/.

The procedure for filling in and sending the application electronically must be completed no later than the fifteenth day following the publication of the notice on the online public notice Board of this University.

The computer application will necessarily require the possession of an e-mail address in order to self-register to the system. The applicant must fill in all the data required to produce the application and attach the documents in electronic PDF format.

The application form must be completed in all its parts, as indicated in the online procedure, and must include a copy of a valid identity document and curriculum vitae.

Once the payment has been made, the applicant must forward the application and check its status, which will change from "draft" to "submitted" mode; the electronic submission of the application is certified by the computer system by means of a receipt that will be automatically sent by e-mail. An application left "in draft" is equivalent to an unsubmitted application.

Each application will be assigned an identification number which, together with the competition code indicated in the IT application, must be specified for any subsequent communication. At the end of submission deadline, the system will no longer allow access and submission of the electronic form. No other forms of sending applications or useful documents for participating in the procedure are allowed.

In case of access to the platform via SPID, the procedure will not require a signature; in all other cases, the application must be signed:

- **by digital signature**, using smart cards, USB tokens or remote signatures, which allow the holder to sign generic documents using signature software on a PC or a web portal for Remote Signature made available by the Certification Authority. Whoever has a smart card or a Digital Signature USB token can verify its compatibility with the Digital Signature system integrated into the server system. In the event of a positive outcome, the holder will be able to sign the application directly on the server (e.g. ConFirma);

- those who do not have compatible digital signature devices and Holders of Remote Digital Signatures who have access to a portal for signing generic documents, must save the PDF file generated by the system on their PC and, without modifying it in any way, digitally sign it in CAdES format: a file with the .p7m extension will be generated which must be re-uploaded on the system. Any amendment made to the file before the Digital Signature is applied will prevent the automatic verification of the correspondence between the content of this document and the original one and this will exclude the application;

- **if it is impossible to use one of the above options**, the candidate must save the PDF file generated by the system on his PC and, without modifying it in any way, print it and affix the complete handwritten signature on the last page of the printout. This complete document must be produced in PDF via scan and the file thus obtained must be uploaded to the system.

Participation in the competition involves the payment of a contribution of \notin 10.00 to cover stationery, organization of tests and postage costs, non-refundable, pending its destination in any eventuality.

The candidate must pay the fee by clicking on the "Paga con Pago PA" button and choose one of the following online payment methods:

- Credit/debit card: for payment with cards;
- Bank account: for direct debit to your account;
- Other payment methods: for example PayPal or Satispay.

The payment of the application fee within the terms and in the manner indicated above is necessary for this Administration for the purpose of preparing and organizing the subsequent phases of the selection procedure and, therefore, is not refundable for any reason (e.g. exclusion, renunciation, absence, etc.) pending its destination.

The candidate must attach the following documentation to the application form by uploading it in the appropriate section of the portal:

- Dated and signed Curriculum vitae, containing the titles deemed useful for the purposes of the competition among those indicated in the following art. 5;
- publications deemed useful for the purposes of the competition;
- photocopy of a valid identity document and tax code.

The administration assumes no responsibility in case of loss of communication due to inaccurate information of the address given by the applicant or failure or delay in communicating the change of

address indicated in the application, nor for any postal problems or in any case due to third parties, unforeseeable circumstances or force majeure.

Once the application has been submitted and the confirmation email has been received it will no longer be possible to make changes; however, the candidate can withdraw the application by clicking on the "Withdraw" button on the home page (dashboard) by filling in the appropriate form; if the call has not yet expired, it will be possible to submit a new application. In this case, the payment made for the withdrawn application may be transferred to the new application.

The IT procedure could be temporarily suspended due to technical reasons; in case of technical problems, you can contact the dedicated support by sending a request to the following link https://pica.cineca.it/uniba.

Candidates who require auxiliary aids and/or additional time to complete the tests must produce a suitable certification issued by the competent public health facility in accordance with articles 4 and 20 of law 104/92.

Art. 4

Statement to be made in the application

In the application, the candidate must declare under his/her own responsibility:

- 1) surname and name (married women must indicate their maiden surname);
- 2) place and date of birth;
- 3) be in possession of one of the requirements set out in art. 2, first paragraph, point 1);
- 4) the Municipality in whose electoral lists you are registered, or the reasons for not registering or for the cancellation from the same lists;
- 5) never having reported criminal convictions and not having criminal proceedings in progress; otherwise, indicate the sentences reported and the date of the sentence of the authority which imposed them (also indicate whether an amnesty, pardon, forgiveness, judicial pardon or non-disclosure was granted, etc.) and pending criminal proceedings;
- 6) be in possession of the qualifications required by art. 2, first paragraph, points 3) and 4), of this notice;
- 7) the position with regard to military obligations;
- 8) having worked in a public administration and not having been dismissed or dispensed for persistent insufficient performance, or not having worked in a public administration nor having been declared forfeited from state employment for having obtained the same job through the production of false documents or documents vitiated by incurable invalidity;
- 9) be in possession of the qualifications that give the right to preference with equal merit, as specified in the following art. 9. The same must be in possession on the expiry date of the deadline for the submission of applications to participate in the competition;
- 10) citizens of the Member States of the European Union must also declare that they enjoy civil and political rights also in the country of origin and provenance, or the reasons for the lack of enjoyment and that they have adequate knowledge of the Italian language;
- 11) the residence indicated for participating in the competition;
- 12) necessary aids in relation to any one's disability and any additional time, pursuant to the law of 5 February 1992, n. 104;

The application must explicitly contain all of the above statements. The omission of the statement referring to point 6) determines the exclusion of the applicant from the competition.

The Administration provides adequate measures to ensure that all subjects with SLD the possibility of using, in the written tests, adequate compensatory tools for reading and writing difficulties, as well as taking advantage of an extension of the established times for carrying out the same test. The adoption of the aforementioned measures will be determined at the sole discretion of the Commission on the

basis of the documentation submitted.

Art. 5

Evaluation of qualifications

Qualifications will be awarded an overall score of 30 points.

The categories of qualifications that can be evaluated, as long as they are relevant to the activities of the available places, are as follows:

1) educational and training qualifications

2) professional experience

3) technical or specialist qualifications

up to a maximum of 15 points; up to a maximum of 10 points; up to a maximum of 5 points.

Art. 6

Selection commission

The Selection Board of the competition will be appointed by Decree of the General Director according to the provisions in force on the subject. The same one will deal, among other things, with the assessment of the admission requirement referred to in the previous art. 2, first paragraph, point 4).

Article 7

Examinations

The exams will consist of a written test and an oral test.

The written test, also with a theoretical/practical content, will focus on concepts linked to investigation methodologies and data analysis with particular reference to the fields of transport, tourism, territory and businesses and the management of support platforms for scientific applications.

The oral test will focus on the topics indicated for the written test, on university legislation, on the use of Microsoft packages (in particular Excel) and/or statistical software (basic level) such as R, STATA, etc.. During the oral test, the knowledge of the English language and the use of IT equipment and the most popular application and data management software have been verified.

The Administration may arrange for the tests to be held through the use of computer and digital tools.

Art. 8

Calendar of tests

The tests will be held according to the following schedule: written test: 6th March 2024 at 14.00 pm; oral exam: 12th March 2024 at 14.00 pm.

The place where the written test will be carried out will be published on the website of the U.O. Procedure concorsuali personale contrattualizzato at the URL:

<u>https://reclutamento.ict.uniba.it/reclutamentopersonale-tec-amm/personale-tecnico-amministrativo</u> within five days before the test itself is held.

This publication represents the only mean of legal publicity and will have the value of personal notification to all interested candidates, exempting the Administration from sending any communication.

Candidates who obtain a score of at least 21 out of 30 in the written test will be admitted to the oral test.

At the time of the written test the Commission will communicate the date of publication of the list of candidates admitted to the oral test. If there is an impediment which affects the publication of the aforesaid list of candidates admitted to the oral test, a postponement of the notice and/or any

postponement of the date of completion of the oral test will be published on the same date.

The oral test will be considered passed if the candidates obtain a minimum score of 21 out of 30.

To be admitted to the exams, candidates must be in possession of one of the following identification documents: identity card, passport, driving licence, nautical licence, firearms licence, identification cards, provided they have a photograph and stamp or other equivalent signature, issued by a State administration.

Non attendance at the tests will be considered as renunciation of the competition.

Art. 9

Preferences with equal merit

Candidates who intend to assert the qualifications that give the right to preference with equal merit must indicate them in the application to participate in the competition. It should also be noted that mendacious or false statements, as well as being punishable under the Penal Code and special laws on the matter, may in the most serious cases lead to temporary disqualification from public office, without prejudice to the forfeiture of any benefits resulting from the provision issued on the basis of the false declaration.

The preferential titles that give the right to preference, in the event of equal score, are the following:

- a) those awarded with the medal for military valor and for civilian valor, if they have left the service;
- b) mutilated and disabled for service in the public and private sectors;
- c) the orphans of the fallen and the children of the mutilated, disabled and permanently unable to work for reasons of service in the public and private sectors, including the children of those in the health professions, social workers and social and health workers who died as a result of SarsCov-2 infection contracted in the service of their work;
- d) those who have rendered commendable service or service without demerit, for whatever reason, for not less than one year in the administration that launched the competition;
- e) greater number of dependent children;
- f) disabled and mutilated civilians who do not fall under (b);
- g) military volunteers of the Armed Forces who have been discharged without demerit at the end of their service or renewal;
- h) athletes who have entertained sports work relationships with military sports groups and civilian bodies of the State;
- i) having successfully completed the additional period of further training at the trial office pursuant to Article 50, Paragraph 1-quater, of Decree Law No. 90 of June 24, 2014, converted, with amendments, by Law No. 114 of August 11, 2014;
- having successfully completed the internship training at judicial offices pursuant to Article 37, Paragraph 11, of Decree-Law No. 98 of July 6, 2011, converted, with amendments, by Law No. 111 of July 15, 2011, while not being part of the trial office, pursuant to Article 50, Paragraph 1quinques, of Decree-Law No. 90 of June 24, 2014; converted, with amendments, by Law No. 114 of August 11, 2014;
- m) having successfully completed the internship at judicial offices pursuant to Article 73, paragraph 14, of Decree-Law No. 69 of June 21, 2013, converted, with amendments, by Law No. 98 of August 9, 2013;
- n) holding or having held collaborative positions conferred by ANPAL Servizi S.p.A., in implementation of the provisions of Article 12, paragraph 3, of Decree-Law No. 4 of January 28, 2019, converted, with amendments, by Law No. 26 of March 28, 2019;
- o) belonging to the least represented gender in the administration announcing the procedure in relation to the qualification for which the candidate is competing. This preference, in relation to the selection in question, applies in favour of women since the distribution of personnel in service until 31/12/2023 for the category and the area of the place put in competition is the following: 100% male gender and 0% female gender;
- p) by the minor age.

Art. 10

Approval of the deeds and of the merit ranking

At the end of the competition procedure, the General Director will approve the competition documents, the related merit list and declare the winner.

The merit list will be drawn up according to the descending order of the points of the overall mark obtained by each candidate in the examination tests, with observance, in the case of equal points, of the preferences established by Article 9. The overall mark will be given by the sum of the marks obtained in the written test, oral test and qualifications.

The merit ranking will be valid as established by current regulations.

The aforementioned measure of approval of deeds will be published on the website of the Competitive Procedures Section of this University at: <u>https://reclutamento.ict.uniba.it/reclutamento-personale-tec-amm/personale-tecnico-amministrativo</u> and on the Online Official Notice Board of this University. The terms for any appeals will start from this date of publication.

Art. 11

Employment with fixed-term employment contract

The winner of the competition will stipulate an individual fixed-term employment contract, with a fulltime hourly commitment, pursuant to the current National Collective Labor Agreement of the University Sector from the resources of the PNRR and in implementation of the measures for staff recruitment.

Art. 12

Presentation of the ritual documents

The winner must, within thirty days of signing the contract, issue a specific declaration made pursuant to art. 46 of the Presidential Decree 28 December 2000, no. 445 which shows:

- a) place and date of birth;
- b) possession of the requirements pursuant to art. 2, point 1 of this announcement;
- c) enjoyment of political rights, including on the date of the deadline for producing the application for admission to the competition;
- d) the position relating to the fulfillment of military obligations;
- e) that they have not reported any criminal offenses (i.e. any criminal convictions they have had, even if they have been granted amnesty, pardon or judicial pardon) and any criminal proceedings against them;
- f) the possession of the requirements of Article 2, first paragraph, points 3), 4) and 5);
- g) the existence or not of other public or private employment relationships or of one of the situations of incompatibility referred to in Article 53 of Legislative Decree No. 165/2001 and if so, relative option for the new employment. Said declaration must contain indications concerning the causes of termination of any previous public employment relationships and must be issued even if negative;
- h) tax code.

Art. 13

Processing of personal data

The personal data contained in the application form will be processed for the purposes of managing this procedure and in application of the regulations in force regarding the processing of personal data. The data will be processed – by the subjects authorized to process it – with manual, IT and telematic tools within the scope and for the purposes specified above, in compliance with the security measures adopted by the University and in compliance with the provisions of EU Regulation no. 2016/679 concerning the protection of natural persons with regard to the processing of personal data and the free movement of such data, as well as the legislative decrees for the adaptation of national legislation to the provisions of the aforementioned Regulation.
